**10. ENTRANT'S LICENCES:**

Where the entrant is NOT the rider, an entrant's licence must be obtained from MSA and submitted together with the entry form, failing which the Entrant's name will not be published in the programme.

**12. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING:**

Self Scrutineering will apply. Compliant forms will be available with the online entry form and must be submitted online. A Scrutineering sticker will be included in the race envelope and must be displayed on the motorcycle. Competitors are warned that should the motorcycle fail a sample spot check any official during any time of the day, then action will be taken against that competitor (Refer to GCR 93 (iii) and SSR 226 in the 2017 MSA National Motocross Standing Supplementary Regulations) – the Stewards to decide appropriate penalty.

**13. RIDERS BRIEFING:**

***18.00 Friday evening 7 April - COMPULSORY***



All riders must be present at the briefing at the stipulated time and venue. Representatives may accompany the rider to the briefing, but may not represent the rider. **Failure to attend the riders briefing may result in a fine of R500**

**14. PRE RACE PADDOCK / WAITING ZONE:**

The Pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone is situated

**Directly behind the start gates**

Before the scheduled start time of the first heat, competitors competing in the race concerned should move to the pre-race paddock / Waiting Zone.

**15. STARTS:**

The Start of the race will be in accordance with SSR 230 – SSR 234 in the 2017 MSA National Motocross Standing Supplementary Regulations

Competitors who do not take part in official practice must confirm their intention to start to the COC, no less than one hour before the start of the first heat.

If a rider is not present in the pre-race paddock when he/she is called to the start line, he/she will forfeit his/her starting position.

A change of vehicle will be permitted subject to valid reasons for the change being given and the Stewards of the meeting agreeing to the change. (Refer to GCR 259)

**16. END OF THE RACE:**

The waving of the chequered flag will signify the end of each race. (Refer to SSR 237 – SSR 240 in the 2017 MSA National Motocross Standing Supplementary Regulations)

The Stewards/COC reserves the right to impound and examine any motorcycle at their discretion

**17. RESULTS:**

Notwithstanding the general protest period laid down in the GCR's, the protest period for motocross will be 15 minutes from actual posting of the FINAL results on the notice board. (Refer to GCR 200, GCR 275 & SSR 255 in the 2017 MSA National Motocross Standing Supplementary Regulations)

These results are not to be removed and disciplinary action will be taken against any person removing these results without authority. Additional copies may be obtained from the Secretary of the meeting.

The meeting will not be postponed, abandoned or cancelled without the consent of the Stewards in accordance with GCR 152.
